Summer Colloquium on Biblical Spirituality Atlanta 2009

“Learn to Do Right, Seek Justice: Biblical Prophets Cry Out to Our World”

Fr. John Donahue, S.J.

June 28-30, 2009, 7:00-9:00 p.m. – St. Jude the Apostle Catholic Church

The prophets of ancient Israel thundered against injustice in their world, but their message is ever relevant to our lives today. By careful reading of select passages from Amos, Isaiah and Jeremiah we hope to open our ears and hearts to their pleas for justice, especially for powerless people in our midst.

Fr. John Donahue, S.J., best-selling author of many books including *The Gospel in Parable* and well known biblical scholar, will be this years featured instructor at our Summer Colloquium on Biblical Spirituality. He is a native of Baltimore Maryland. He entered the Society of Jesus in 1951 and was ordained a priest in 1964 after studying at Fordham University and Woodstock College in Maryland. He earned his Ph.D. in New Testament from the University of Chicago, with a doctoral thesis on the Gospel of Mark. Fr. Donahue has held numerous teaching positions at schools across the country and abroad including the Vanderbilt School of Divinity, the Jesuit School of Theology at Berkeley, the Pontifical Biblical Institute in Rome, University of Notre Dame and St. Mary's Seminary and University. He has also been a very popular guest faculty member at the Summer Insitute in Mobile. Currently, he serves as Research Professor in Theology at Loyola College in Maryland. Some of his other notable accomplishments include being the first Raymond E. Brown Distinguished Professor of New Testament Studies at St. Mary's and being a past president of the Catholic Biblical Association.

SPT 535: Amos: Prophet of Justice (biblical). The Colloquium can also be taken as a one-credit course, with further readings and assignments, which build on and expand the three presentations, under the direction of Dr. Carmody.
