3, 5 OR 8-DAY SILENT IGNATIAN DIRECTED RETREAT

**Thursday evening, June 8 - Friday, June
16 we will offer individually directed
silent retreats following the dynamics
of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius
on our 380-acre campus in Mobile.**

Participants may register for either 3,
5 or 8 full days of retreat. The 8-day
retreat begins with a short orientation on
Thursday, June 8, at 7:30 p.m., and ends
after lunch on Friday, June 16. The 8-day
retreatants will begin their first full retreat
day on June 9. The 5 and 3-day retreats
may be taken for any 5 or 3 consecutive
days during this time period; retreatants
will receive a brief orientation session on
the evening before their first day. Room
and board are included in the cost.
