2024 GUEST **LECTURERS**



Dr. Nicholas P. Wood is an assistant professor at Spring Hill College, where he teaches courses on early American history. After earning his PhD at the University of Virginia, he held

postdoctoral fellowships at Yale University and the Library Company of Philadelphia before coming to Spring Hill. Wood's scholarship focuses on the role of religion in the antislavery movement and has been supported by many archives and organizations, including the National Endowment for the Humanities and the Society of Colonial Wars. Wood's scholarly essays have appeared in venues such as the William and Mary Quarterly and the Journal of the Early Republic; his book manuscript, Let the Oppressed Go Free: The Revolutionary Generation of American Abolitionists, will be published by the University of Pennsylvania Press.
