

Visiting Assistant Professor/Chemistry

The Division of Science and Mathematics at Spring Hill College, a Jesuit liberal arts college in Mobile, AL, invites applications for a one-year Visiting Assistant Professor position starting Fall 2024. This appointment is for one year, with the potential for a longer-term appointment, based upon the needs of the College as well as the applicant's qualifications and performance. The successful applicant will teach 12 credit hours or 15 contact hours per semester, with a focus on physical chemistry plus labs and inorganic chemistry plus labs (along with general chemistry plus labs).

The candidate should have a Ph.D. in Chemistry (or equivalent field) by the time of application, a commitment to pursuing excellence in undergraduate teaching and student mentoring, and a willingness to support the Jesuit mission (<http://www.shc.edu>). The department offers Bachelor of Science degrees (and minors) in either Chemistry or Biochemistry, supports an interdisciplinary Forensic Sciences minor, and offers general core courses to the student body. Preference will be given to candidates specializing in Physical Chemistry with the ability to teach Inorganic Chemistry, although applicants from other related fields of Chemistry are encouraged to apply.

Applications including a letter of interest (including interest in and experience working with diverse student populations), current CV, unofficial graduate and undergraduate transcripts, statements on teaching philosophy and potential research project(s) suitable for undergraduate student engagement, and three letters of recommendation, at least one of which discusses a candidate's teaching qualifications, should be submitted to chemistry@shc.edu. Review of applications is ongoing and will continue until the position is filled. All candidates must have legal authorization to work in the United States.
